Scholarship Application Instructions

Important: Recruited athletes MAY NOT receive awards in this program

The Baylor Alumni Association (BAA) provides one-time and multi-year awards to outstanding students. Scholarship will only be awarded to those students who are children of Baylor alumni and to students who are admitted and enrolled at Baylor University. Application materials must be received by the BAA Scholarship Committee by the deadline listed below. Late or incomplete applications will not be processed, regardless of the reason(s) for their being late or incomplete. You will be notified via regular mail or e-mail as to the status of your application. ***All material will be photocopied for selection committee members, so please be sure to type or print firmly with dark ink.***

COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKETS WILL INCLUDE:

1. Two (2) page **application form**.
2. Official high school **transcript** (if a transfer student, also attach transcripts from other colleges attended).
3. A resume which keeps to the following format (**PLEASE LIMIT TWO (2) PAGES**):
 - a. **Academic Honors/Achievements** — List the honor/achievement as well as a brief explanation of the honor.
 - b. **School Sponsored Extracurricular Activities** — List the activity name and include a brief description of the organization, your personal contribution to the organization, and any honors, awards, or leadership positions held.
 - c. **Non-school Sponsored Events** — List the activity name and include a description of the organization, your personal contribution to the organization, and any honors, awards, or leadership positions held.
 - d. **Work Experience** — List the job with title description, your contribution to the workplace, and any honors, leadership, or recognition received.
4. A copy of your **SAT** or **ACT scores**, if not included on transcript.
5. Two (2) typed **essays**. You may choose any **TWO** from the three options below:

Option 1: Describe a significant setback, challenge or opportunity in your life and the impact that it has had on you.

Option 2: Many students expand their view of the world during their time in college. Such growth often results from encounters between students who have lived different cultural, economic, or academic experiences. With your future growth in mind, describe a potential classmate that you believe you could learn from either within or outside a formal classroom environment.

Option 3: Describe and evaluate one experience that significantly influenced your academic or personal interests. The experience might be a high school course, a hob, a relationship, or an extracurricular activity. Be sure to explain how this experience led you to set the goals you now have for yourself.

This is not the time for you to be modest! Let the selection committee get to know you and what makes you uniquely qualified to receive this honor. Writing mechanics are important and will be considered.

Please limit your essay responses to two-typed pages, double-spaced, and include your name at the top of each page.
